

#### **Encouraging the Next Generation of Pro-Life Leaders**

RTL of NCI is committed to educating and equipping young people to become pro-life leaders. Each spring we promote Pro-Life T-Shirt Day.

In past years 500 to 700 students have purchased pro-life t-shirts. Each student receives a booklet with pro-life information they can share with their peers.





RTL of NCI sponsors annual Life Defenders workshops for high school and college students. Using science and philosophy, Life Defenders equips students with the tools to educate their peers about life-related issues. RTL of NCI partners with Allen County Right to Life to take students to the January National March for Life in Washington, D.C.

#### **Memorial Cross Display**



The Cross Display reminds people of abortion's impact on north central Indiana. Since 1982 over 8,300 abortions (93 in 2016) have been performed on women from just Kosciusko, Whitley, Wabash, Fulton and Grant counties. Each year this display will be placed in several locations.

#### Mobile Pregnancy Center Ministry

RTL of NCI partners with Heartline Pregnancy Center to serve abortion-vulnerable women through the ICU Mobile unit. The Mobile provides free pregnancy tests and free ultrasounds. ICU Mobile affiliates across the country have reported 87% of abortion-minded women will choose life after seeing



an ultrasound of their unborn baby. Almost 40% of these women will accept Christ through the relationship with the pregnancy center staff.

RTL of NCI realizes that no matter how much we encourage women to continue their pregnancies many of them may still choose abortion without personal support and encouragement. RTL of NCI is committed to making sure that people know about pregnancy resource center services. Billboards promoting area pregnancy resource centers are paid for by RTL of NCI.

#### **Education Through Media**

Right to Life of North Central Indiana promotes the prolife message through billboards, banners, and radio spots. Over 50,000 cars will pass by at least one pro-life billboard in north central Indiana each day.



#### **Abortions in North Central Indiana**

Many of RTL of NCI's efforts are directed towards encouraging people to value human life with the primary objective being a reduction in the number of abortions performed on women from north central Indiana. Since there is no abortion facility in north central Indiana, women travel to other cities for their abortions.

Less abortions not only mean less babies dying but also fewer women experiencing the negative physical and emotional consequences of abortion. The goal is to see the number of women choosing life increase and ultimately have every baby in north central Indiana welcomed into the world rather than looked at as something to be discarded.
