That adoption happened when George was eighteen months old. Today George has twelve siblings - nine of his brothers and sisters are also adopted and they represent six different countries.

His testimony of a victorious, overcoming life has inspired thousands of people all over the world. George has been on television and radio, performed and spoken at hundreds of live events, and has shared the stage with national acts like: Jeremy Camp, Audio Adrenaline, Hillsong United, Colton Dixon, Toby Mac, Jamie Grace, For King and Country, and Mercy Me.
